The P Plate Piano program includes access to this website which provides a range of teaching resources and activities for students to reinforce their learning. There are videos demonstrating teaching techniques and tips for presenting the program to students. A forum is also available for teachers and parents to share ideas and experiences, alongside a Hall of Fame showcasing student performances.



Assessment

Optional non-graded assessments are available at the completion of each book. Students can perform pieces selected for assessment alone or in groups and parent and teacher participation is encouraged. There is no requirement for technical work, sight reading or general knowledge. At the end of the performance an AMEB examiner will provide an assessment report with a certificate acknowledging the student's achievement issued by the AMEB. On completion of the series, students will receive a credit card style P-Plate Piano licence. Please note that the way assessments in P Plate Piano are conducted may vary from state to state.
