

Piano Old (2018) Syllabus withdrawn

From 2022, candidates can no longer present technical work or list items from the Old (2018) Piano syllabus. The New (2022) Piano syllabus is required by all candidates for correct exam preparation.

Components of the Piano syllabus are:

- *Piano Technical work Level 1 (2018) and Piano Technical work Level 2 (2018)*
- *AMEB Series 17 grade books (Preliminary to Grade 8)*
- *AMEB Series 18 grade books (Preliminary to Grade 8)*
- Manual list items as published in the 2022 Piano syllabus



Series 15 and 16 grade books cannot be used as List pieces

Although these pieces can be used for Extra List (Comprehensive exam) or Own Choice (Repertoire exam) items in 2022, they can no longer be presented as List pieces unless particular pieces from these books can be found in the 2022 manual lists.

Grade 1 Piano – canons cannot be presented in exams

The Canon that used to form part of the technical work in the Old (2018) Piano syllabus is no longer required in Grade 1 piano examinations. Due to the shorter duration of a canon in comparison to the listed repertoire, teachers should also note that the **canon cannot be presented as an Own Choice item** in Grade 1 Piano or Piano for Leisure repertoire exams.
